

act for transformation is a non-profit association working with a small, experienced and dedicated team in the areas of education and development cooperation. The association offers workshops on global learning, intercultural awareness and peace-building to schools and other institutions and is involved in and committed to the work with refugees. Together with BUND-Ostwuerttemberg (Friends of the Earth Germany) the Um-Welthaus (One-World-House) Aalen was opened in autumn 2014. It offers a One-World and environmental education classroom as well as exhibition space, offices and seminar rooms.

We started our volunteer and youth exchange program with Georgia and Eastern Europe as well as African countries. Act for transformation has long partnerships with Peace Groups and Civil Society in the Caucasus area and Sudan. With the support of German Government funding we can offer two volunteer places in the Um-Welthaus Aalen.

Activities

- Contribute to projects and the work in Um-Welthaus of act for transformation and Friends of the Earth
- Preparation of information about the volunteer program and civil society organizations in Georgia
- Work with refugees, especially with children and offer regular and holiday activities for them

The volunteers have the possibility to get to know civil-society projects in Germany, to implement own ideas and initiate own projects and participate in workshops in Germany.



The position will start in May/June and is funded by German Volunteer Service with a monthly pocket money (250 €) plus transport; accommodation and food in a host family are provided.
